#### II. CWS Report

- Trevor Russel from City Wide Security (CWS) gave an update regarding patrols in the district.
- Crimes sexual misconduct (1<sup>st</sup> degree), property damage on Giles, assault-resisting arrestpeace disturbance and fugitive warrants, assault (1<sup>st</sup>) shooting, domestic assault (stealing from a person at Gelateria)
- In general, crime activity is slow ... most activity in area 4
- 5-6 officers currently on staff (just added another officer)
- Several shifts have not been filled ... Trevor will go back to the schedules to see if there is any consistency to which officer(s) are missing shifts.

### III. Business Administrator Report

- YTD budget was presented (through March 30, 2019). First disbursement was received from the City of St. Louis in the amount of \$108,008. YTD spending \$25,160, with \$23,100 being spent on security patrols (which includes 4 weeks of patrols in 2018).
- T.Hoffman to follow-up with MOPERM policy to determine if it covers only errors & ommissions (E&O) or whether it also includes personal liability.

#### IV. Old Business

- T.Hoffman to follow-up with Mayor's office re: new board member expiration dates and how to expedite current in-process applications.
- T.Hoffman to follow-up with Megan Green to determine if 2019 budget and annual report were submitted to (and approved by) the Board of Aldermen.
- T.Hoffman to get pricing for moveable signage for meeting announcements.
  - A-frame, easel signs (metal, tall, 2-two sided signs for each frame)

- 2-signs for each frame with 2-sided messages on each sign (one for monthly meeting and one for annual meeting).
- Overall qty target 15-20.

## V. New Business

 The Board reviewed its commitment re: the installation of security cameras within the District boundaries. \$30,000 has been budgeted in 2019 for installation/operating expenses for initial phase. T.Hoffman to follow-up with Bill Clendenin (Soulard Camera System coordinator) to determine if he can attend a future TGSCC Board Meeting to discuss immediate next steps for camera deployment.
