# Neighborhood Security Camera's General Scope & Costs (Per Camera Installation/Location)

- Purchase
  - o 3-4 cameras per location (\$1,000 / camera)
  - o one computer server per location (\$1,000)
- Installation
  - o 2X purchase cost
- Software & Licensing Fees
  - o \$500 per location annually
- Internet Connection (Charter)
  - o \$150 \$200 / month per location
- Maintenance Fees
  - o 10% of purchase cost annually
- Example for 3 locations with 2 cameras per location
  - o Purchase \$9,000 (\$6,000 cameras and \$3,000 servers)
  - o Installation \$12,000
  - Software & licensing fees \$1,500
  - Internet \$5,400 \$7,200 annually
  - Maintenance \$900 annually
  - o Total Cost
    - Year #1 \$28,800 \$30,600
    - Year #2 and beyond \$7,800 \$9,600
